IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND ONE AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE FEEDING OF RACCOONS, SKUNKS AND COYOTES IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1:00

No person shall intentionally feed or cause to have fed any non-domesticated Raccoons, skunks and/or coyotes within the City of Lynn.

SECTION 2:00

No person shall take any action(s) which intentionally cause raccoons, skunks and/or coyotes to congregate, thereby creating or causing a health and/or safety hazard within the city limits.

SECTION 3:00

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 4:00

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5:00

This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final adoption as advertised.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE FEEDING OF
GEESE OR WILD BIRDS ON OR ABOUT SLUICE POND AND FLAX POND
IN THE CITY OF LYNN -----**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:-

SECTION 1:00

No person shall feed any wild geese and ducks or other wildlife that may congregate or gather on or about Sluice Pond, Flax Pond, Buchanan Bridge and/or Goldfish Pond.

SECTION 2:00

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 3:00

The Health Department shall be the enforcing authority for all purposes.

SECTION 4:00

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed:

SECTION 5:00

This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final adoption as advertised.
